

Wholesale Acquisition Cost Information for Colorado Prescribers

Colorado law requires prescription drug manufacturers to disclose in writing to Colorado prescribers the Wholesale Acquisition Cost (“WAC”) of marketed drugs when engaging in prescription drug marketing (Colorado Revised Statutes Section 12-42.5-308). This disclosure provides the WAC price for the product listed below.

WAC price represents the manufacturer’s published catalog or list price for a drug product to wholesalers as reported to third-party drug pricing publishers and does not include discounts, rebates, or reductions in price.

Colorado law also requires manufacturers to provide the names of generic prescription drugs from the same therapeutic class as the marketed products. There are no generic prescription drugs applicable to the above prescription drug.
